



# CROSS COUNTRY SASKATCHEWAN

## **Level 2 Officials Course: November 23-25, 2018 Saskatoon, SK**

### **Who Should Take This Course and Why?**

This course is designed to train Level 1 Cross Country Ski Officials to the Level 2 category. Level 2 Officials at a race event are the “Chiefs” who are responsible for small volunteer teams (e.g. “Chief of Start”, Chief of Stadium, etc). Attendees may also want to be more knowledgeable as a race volunteer without necessarily being in a Chief role.

It is important that clubs who wish to host Sask Cup races or the Provincial Championships continue to develop Level 1 Officials (for their individual roles as race volunteers), Level 2 Officials (race chiefs/supervisors) and Level 3 Officials (for Chief of Competition/Technical Delegate roles). Having knowledgeable and experienced volunteer Officials is a Cross Country Saskatchewan and Cross Country Canada expectation of host clubs – to assure delivery of an excellent race experience for the athletes.

**Format:** The course includes classroom lectures, race video review and outdoor exercises so bring outdoor clothing. All equipment is supplied.

**Prerequisites:** Level 2 requires previous Level 1 certification and some volunteer experience at cross country ski races. You can now take the Level 1 course on-line. We will send those who register on Zone4 further instructions on how to log on to the CCC Officials website. Successful completion of a short online pre-course test and a slightly longer online post-course test, both open-book, will be required.
