The CCS High Performance Program will support up to three individuals through a daily per diem, travel and accommodation costs and approved race related expenses.

HEAD COACH – National Championships

Qualifications:

- Minimum NCCP training: CCI (L2T) or old NCCP level II
 - Preference will be given to coaches with higher NCCP training
- Prior experience as a lead coach or assistant coach to athletes
- Prior experience at a National-level cross country ski event is preferred
- Priority preference will be given to the following in the order in which they appear:
 - Past experience coaching cross-country ski athletes at Canada Winter Games
 - Past experience as the head coach of athletes at National Cross-Country Ski Championships
 - Past experience as the head coach of athletes at Western Cross-Country Ski Championships
- Several years' experience working with High Performance athletes at the provincial level
- Extensive technical training and experience in ski preparation and use of ski waxes
- Strong leadership, inter-personal and communication skills
- Valid driver's license
- Knowledge of the CCS High Performance program
- Knowledge of the CCC/FIS Rules and regulations
- Criminal record and Vulnerable Sector check
- Have strong skills in cross country skiing for both skate and classic technique.

Duties

- Work with CCS selected athletes once they are finalized to ensure athlete has suitable training schedule and work with athlete's club coach as required to have athlete prepared for the event
- Provide coaching and waxing support during the event
- Provide pre-race course ski with all athletes to familiarize the athlete to their respective race course
- Assist each athlete through race management, encouragement and supervision to facilitate the athlete's peak performance.
- Attend all coaches meetings throughout the event
- To support their athletes throughout the event, lodging protests as required and acting in the athlete's best interest
- Report to the High Performance Director and provide a summary of the event and results

CCS Obligations:

- CCS will pay the Head Coach an honorarium and travel, accommodation and meal expenses for attendance at the event
- Insure the Coach against risk of liability which might occur while athletes are participating in Team Training or competition at the event
- Booking all required accommodations and travel arrangements
- Notifying the Coach of the athletes that they are responsible for
- CCS will provide the Head Coach with a coaching contract

A contract will be formed between CCS and the successful applicant stipulating the coach's salary, other expenses, and payment schedule.

- Several years' experience working with High Performance athletes at the club level
- extensive technical training and experience in ski preparation and use of ski waxes
- Strong leadership, inter-personal and communication skills
- Valid driver's license
- Knowledge of the CCS High Performance program
- Knowledge of the CCC/FIS Rules and regulations
- Criminal record and Vulnerable Sector check
- Have skills in cross country skiing for both skate and classic technique in order to effectively test race waxes

Duties

- Work in conjunction with CCS High Performance Coach, Nationals Head Coach and Nationals Assistant Coach
- Testing and application of race and training waxes during the race trip
- Set up and organization of wax room
- Advise athletes on ski and wax selection
- If time allows, support of athletes on race course

CCS Obligations:

- CCS will pay the Wax Technician an honorarium and travel, accommodation and meal expenses for attendance at the event
- Insure the Wax Technician against risk of liability which might occur while athletes are participating in Team Training or competition at the event
- Booking all required accommodations
- Notifying the Coach of the athletes that they are responsible for
- CCS will provide the Wax Technician with a work contract
